Update on Congressional Fellows Group (Ad Hoc)-Jen Nekuda Malik

Glenn is working with Todd Osman on a welcome for the new Fellow and farewell for the outgoing Fellow. If MRS has funds available to attend, Jen would make time in her schedule to attend the welcome and farewell. Otherwise, Glenn will do both.

Update on FY24 Congressional Activities & Expected Final Action - Glenn Ruskin

The House Appropriations Committee approved 10 of the 12 bills; still remaining are the appropriations which cover NIST, NASA, and NSF. The Senate Appropriations Committee has approved all 12 bills. The full House and Senate need to pass their bills when they return from August recess.

The new fiscal year begins October 1. Each bill has to be reconciled between the House and Senate versions before October 1. The numbers aren't far apart, so it could go smoothly but there's a lot of work ahead, and a short-term spending Continuing Resolution is a possibility.

Update on ACS-MRS Space Materials Capitol Hill Briefing - September 20, 2023

Glenn is working on getting honorary Congressional co-hosts and room location.

ACS will pay the costs of the event, MRS provides the speaker.

Speaker: Othmane Benafan, materials research engineer, NASA Glenn Center, Ohio.

Action; Glenn will send him the required official invitation letter, and Benafan will need to get NASA approval to participate.

Action: Glenn will seek approval to stream the session for ACS and MRS members; it will be open to MRS members whether it's live or after the fact.

Glenn is also looking for a second speaker. Action: Loucas suggested that Glenn reach out to GAC member Jeff Aguilar of Lockheed Martin, who wrote the MRS Space Materials White Paper.

Fall CVD

Agency Visits Day

AVD is better in person but Zoom could be considered.

It makes sense to do the Agency Summit in October or November; the agencies will know the FY24 budgets.

The last Agency Summit was quite effective with good exchanges off the record and good interaction with the program managers.

The benefit to the participants increases if there are 6 or 7 agencies taking part.

Having it at AAAS in DC will be more efficient for the agencies versus travel to an MRS meeting.
