New Books Editorial Board Chair

Linda announced that Francesca Iacopi of the University of Technology Sydney will be the new Books Editorial Board Chair. She asked the committee for suggestions for Editorial Board Members. Current members include: Ron Gibala, Neville Moody, and Xiaoqing Pan. Linda suggested Yunfeng Shi of Rensselaer.

Discussion about the books series:

The series includes textbooks and monographs. The new Chair will work with the Board and Springer Nature on the strategic focus for commissioning (readership, topical focus).

A model similar to Annual Reviews might be considered, with editors compiling topical volumes each year. This might be similar to the MRS Bulletin Volume Organizer model (which has been discontinued as of 2023).

Tutorials, webinars, and Symposium X are a good resource for book content. We might consider providing transcripts to facilitate the process for authors. Question and answer could be an appendix.

Reference books, partnering with organizations like NIST, may be worth investigating.

MRS Energy & Sustainability Editor-in-Chief (EIC) Search

Shirley Meng will step down as MRS Energy & Sustainability EIC in May 2024. A Search Task Force will begin work soon, with a goal of interviewing candidates in late summer. Publications Committee suggestions for EIC candidates are welcome.

New Publications Committee Members

Linda would like to expand the Publications Committee roster and increase diversity, and asked the committee members for suggestions. Eileen will send lists of recent Meeting Chairs and Symposium Organizers (ideally those who have served multiple times). Rich suggested Rajesh Naik and Wendy Goodson.

The suggestion was made that we compile a list of meeting chairs and multiple symposium organizers and then look at their publishing activity in MRS to see if people come to the forefront. This would be a less biased way to look for additional members.
