Current Publications Committee – want additional members and more diversity Alliance with Springer Nature

Impact Factors – two new journal Impact Factors, including MRS Energy & Sustainability with a 4.3; usage is increasing; submissions up, downloads up

Shirley Meng's term concludes in May 2024; goal is to select a new EIC by Q1 2024 Recent Publications Activities and Initiatives – a lot going on to get the word out and increase submissions

Editorial Strategic Planning Subcommittee – focus on strategic planning and decision-making Books Editorial Board – Ram Devanathan and new board members

### Discussion:

- Impact Factors (IF) have not yet increased across the board with Springer Nature alliance
- overall citations year-to-year are increasing
- 2022 IF includes 2020 Cambridge content; anticipate increases with 2023 IF
- Information provided by Springer Nature to help us be strategic in publications
  - Help see which topics are trending up or down. Can reports provide useful input to MTGC?
  - o Eileen and Gopal to share reports/data with Lincoln for MTGC review/analysis
- Ideas for new journals don't have the human capital to take on another journal at this time
