Engage

- Challenge assumptions, seek clarity and add value.

Respect

- Pay attention to presentations and discussions.
- Appreciate the opinions and efforts of others
- Support the Board decision

Lead

- See the "big picture"
- Give strategic guidance to working groups
- "Table" discussions, charging working groups to come back with more information
